

Hi Everybody -

After a great deal of thought and discussion, we have made a decision regarding our Loyalty Reward Points Program and wanted to make you aware. For the past 5 years, many of you have enjoyed the savings from our Loyalty Reward Points program (a program that allows you to collect reward points based on your purchases, which can be used as "cash" on future purchases from the Studio.) Over the years the costs of maintaining this program have risen but we have managed to avoid making any changes or reductions to the program. However, we have been notified that costs for the program will shortly be rising again. We believe that we have reached the stage where the costs outweigh the benefits of the program for both the Studio and you. Therefore we have decided to permanently cease the Loyalty Reward Points Program as of December 31, 2024. What does this mean for you?

- You will continue to earn and redeem reward points as per our usual program until December 31, 2024 (earn 3 points for each \$1 purchase of physical merchandise redeem points once a minimum of 250 points has been earned)
- As of January 1, 2025 you will be able to redeem your points at any time without a minimum accrual
- all points must be redeemed by February 28, 2025. Any points balances remaining after that date will be forfeited.
